The Basic Sailing course you are about to begin is an exciting but demanding challenge.

You will be required to provide a life jacket (vest type) which should be Coast Guard approved, the proper size for your weight and build, and be form fitting and comfortable, as you will be wearing it at all times during the course. Closed toe footwear (old tennis or boat shoes) will be worn at all times, both on land and on the water to protect your feet. No sandals or flip-flops. Be prepared to get wet and spend a significant amount of time under the Sun during this course. We recommend you bring adequate sun protection (hat, sunscreen, sunglasses, etc) and a change of clothes and towel to each class to dry off after sailing.

I understand that in entering this sailing course, I agree to obey all program rules as set forth by the program director and the instructors; that I will use utmost care in the use of the boats and equipment; that I will not engage in any horseplay or other disruptive behavior.

I accept that the sport of sailing and the conduct of this course entail and are subject to certain inherent risks and assume all risks on land and on the water of participation in this program. I further agree to hold the Titusville Sailing Club, Brevard County Chapter of the American Red Cross and their representatives harmless for any personal injuries and/or property damage that result during this course.
